Instructions For Use To use in conjunction with Bristol Paints, firstly a base colour should

be applied. For the final coat intermix 25% of **Aqua**Plus to the colour for a more durable finish. To use **Aqua**Plus as a top dressing stir well before use. Dilute with a ratio of 1:1 or up to 1:2 depending on the

porosity of the substrate and the amount of sheen required.
